

Do you import or sell products that contain herbal substances that may be medicinal?

Products previously notified with the Malta Standards Authority (MSA) as food supplements or cosmetics may now fall under the herbal traditional medicinal product legislation.

To be placed on the market, these products need to be registered with the Medicines Authority by end September 2010. All herbal medicines without the required information sent by end September 2010, cannot be placed on the market after March 2011.
