The second call for proposals for the Innovative Medicines Initiative was launched on the 17th of November 2009. The funding available for the new call is €76.8 million provided by the European Commission, plus at least matching in kind contributions from member companies of the European Federation of Pharmaceutical Industries and Associations (EFPIA).
